### **PUBLIC INFORMATION POLICY**

Landscape Architectural Accreditation Board (LAAB) accredited programs are required to provide reliable information to the public. Programs must report on accreditation status and its performance. This information is to help potential students make informed application decisions.

### **ACCREDITATION**

The four-year program in landscape architecture is accredited by the Landscape Architectural Accreditation Board and recognized by the Landscape Architects Technical Committee of the California Board of Architectural Examiners. ### **COST OF ATTENDANCE**

Costs to attend UC Davis will vary, depending on the living situation the student chooses. The following chart represents an estimate of typical expenses for a student living on campus:

## RETENTION AND GRADUATION RATES

The program expects time to graduation to be 4 years for students entering the major as freshman, 3 years for students entering as transfer students, and 3 years for students changing into the LDA major from the point of transition. Information supplied by the CA&ES Dean's Office indicates that the average time to degree for LDA majors is 4.5 years. The following table on retention rates shows that problems with students failing to graduate on time are limited to approximately 0- 6 students per year, or one-eighth of our annual cohort:
