**Major Requirements Minor Requirements** 

- PLEASE BE ADVISED: Attempting to complete the major in 3 years will require multiple quarters (including summers) with heavy course loads. Only students especially willing and able should attempt to complete the major in 3 years and must obtain approval from an academic advisor
- This is a sample academic plan. Your academic plan will differ depending on previous credit received, prerequisites taken for upper division track class, your course schedule, and available offerings.
- CRD Tracks: Global Communities, Policy and Planning and Social Services, and Organization and Management. Students may choose either track and complete six 4-unit courses (24 total units) with one course being an Upper Division CRD course DIFFERENT from the Depth Subject Matter CRD courses.
- Please be aware that Track courses may have prerequisites that are not accounted for on this plan, it is your responsibility to take prerequisites for upper division track courses that you are planning to take.
- Students are strongly advised to work with an academic advisor to determine a personalized study plan.
- For CRD Major: 7 lower division courses (including lower div English) and 21 upper division courses (including upper div English) = total of 24 classes (Please note: The 5 unit CRD Depth courses are the methods courses; CRD 150, CRD 151, and CRD 156)
- This schedule meets CAES minimum 180 unit requirement for graduation, meets CAES 54 Upper division unit requirement for upper division courses, meets Community and Regional Development major requirements, meets GE requirements, meets English composition requirement
- Please work with College of Agriculture Dean's Office to choose GE classes to ensure that all General Education requirements are met.
