- <u>**REQUIRED:**</u> File for graduation (**candidacy**) online at http://registrar.ucdavis.edu/graduation <u>or</u> in the Office of the Registrar during the specified dates listed in the Class Schedule and Registration Guide or the current General Catalog (filing period based expected graduation term indicated on reverse side: \_\_\_\_\_)
- Meet with your adviser to complete a **Major Certification** form this must be filed by the 10th day of the quarter in which you plan to graduate
- **OPTIONAL:** Apply for participation in the commencement **ceremony** online (deadline to participate may be different from above) at http://www.caes.ucdavis.edu/NewsEvents/Events/Commencement
- Submit **minor** petitions by the 10<sup>th</sup> day of the quarter in which you plan to graduate to the CA&ES Dean's Office
- Petition for change of **Incomplete grades** this form is available in the Office of the Registrar. Grades required for your degree must be filed with the instructor no later than one week after the final day of your quarter of graduation *(not to be confused with the Academic Senate three quarter deadline in which to make up an incomplete)*. If you plan on not completing "incomplete" grades refer to the General Catalog on how this might affect your graduation.
